Participants will be divided into activity field groups **based on their age** to make all activities age-appropriate and encourage making new friends among their peers.

Four activity fields will be located on camp grounds in Tagametsa, the Adventurer field will welcome participants and their leaders in a nearby town **Viljandi** to offer a broader sense of the Estonian experience.

VILJANDI TOWN

Viljandi is a city in southern Estonia with a population of around 17 000 people. With a beautiful lake, loads of museums and activities, it makes the perfect **Adventurer activity field** for the Baltic Jamboree.



Participants will take part in a curated programme with activities that introduce the Estonian culture but there will also be free time to explore!

HIKE

For the **regular hike**, participants will be split into **two age groups**.

11-13-year-olds will hike for about 14 kilometers, 14-15-year-olds for 18 kilometers.

The hike trail follows mostly forest paths and smaller gravel roads. All check-points are manned, in addition there are extra activities along the hike to gather extra points.

All groups have **10 participants**, a fantastic mix of Estonians, Latvians, Lithuanians, and other nationalities.

24H HIKE

The **24h hike** begins at the Tagametsa scouting campsite and ends at the Laose guiding campsite, with participants navigating with a given map with the intent of finishing in exactly 24 hours.

Each team has 5-6 members aged 16-17.

Everyone aged 16-17 is expected to participate, in exceptional cases it is possible to join the regular hike. **Registration will begin soon through your HoC!**

There are three exciting consecutive parts, **each 8 hours long**:

Biking

along even, but versatile terrain in the forest, on gravel roads and asphalt.

Canoeing

along the adventurous river Vigala, requiring great teamwork.

Hiking

on foot, which will mostly happen in the dark of the night using necessary safety gear.



FOREST CAFE

A place for just participants!

At the Forest cafe you will be able to purchase **sweet and savory snacks**, you'll need cash.

But more importantly, this is a safe space to meet new people, take part in the special programme and play board games. There will also be activites for different national days.

At the end of each day, a **fun-filled slideshow** will be revealed so make sure to capture your favourite moments to showcase!



BOOKWORM



Do you remember meeting the hike-loving Adventurer in the first newsletter? Say hi to their friend **the Hedgehog**, who will bring you the introduction of our different hikes and the IST experience!

The Bookworm has spent most of their days in the local library devouring books on every subject they could get their hands on. Through that, a special love for Baltic myths and tales has blossomed, and they've learned how to identify different types of trees and plants.


